



MEETING SPACES AT SEVEN CIRCLES RETREAT CENTER

The Lodge: The main dining hall has a large brick fireplace, a piano and lots of percussion instruments. French doors open onto a covered patio with picnic tables and two barbecues (charcoal and propane). Refreshment area always available – coffee, tea, ice water, microwave oven. Additional information:

- 25 feet by 17 feet meeting space
- Two restrooms
- 8 foot folding tables and folding chairs
- Full commercial kitchen with adjacent food service area
- Office with computer, Internet, fax, copier and long-distance telephone (no additional charges)

The Yurt: This round building is based on a Mongolian design and has interior open space with no posts. A skylight lets in sunlight – and moonlight. Additional information:

- 30 foot diameter round building (706 sq ft)
- Wood floor – optional carpeting
- Stacking chairs

Creekside Room: An intimate carpeted meeting room with sofa and easy chairs. French doors have a view of Badger Creek. Additional information:

- Meeting space is 20 feet by 16 feet
- Entertainment center with television and DVD/video player
- Adjacent laundry facilities

Longhouse: A meeting and living space with living room, bedroom (two twin beds), and bathroom. Tucked under a sequoia tree by Badger Creek. Additional information:

- Meeting space is 20 feet by 14 feet
- Stacking chairs, table and folding chairs

OUTDOOR SPACES: All these areas are across Badger Creek, accessed by a wooden bridge. The Meadow is a flat area where a meeting tent or open-air meetings can be set up. The Hamid Camp Amphitheater is a natural rock area. The Gazebo features an old stone altar and is a peaceful space for individual or small group reflection.
